To write a motion

A motion is written by following simple guidelines, these are made up by:

- a clear headline
- name of the mover
- a short body
 - background to the issue
 - short argument
- **Conclusion** with **proposals for decision** making expressed clearly, through one or more "to-sentences"

Motion to the 2018 fall semester assembly of the A-guild

Regarding: Swimming pool for the A guild **Mover:** Full name
